



## ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM

The Lock-Up's Artist in Residence Program encourages practitioners from diverse disciplines to apply. Each residency is of a period between 2 – 4 weeks, depending on the needs and practice of each applicant.

The program is funded by the University of Newcastle who provide a stipend payable to each resident. The stipend assists with the travel and living costs associated with the residency and is negotiated between the Lock-Up and the applicant, following a successful application.

Due to the Lock-Up's partnerships, it is common practice for each resident to be involved in the following programs – The University of Newcastle Guest Lecture Program and the Hunter TAFE Guest Lecture Program. Additionally, applicants may consider holding floor talks, workshops or public seminars/forums through the Lock-Up or the Hunter Writers Centre.

## SUPPORTING MATERIAL

The following are considered suitable support material for an application:

- No more than 10 digital images
- One DVD of no longer than 10 minutes in duration
- Publications – if applicable

Applicants may provide a combination of the above, if it is appropriate to their practice. However, the material provided should equate to no more than what is outlined.

## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered a successful application of the Lock-Up's AiR Program, the following are required:

- A current CV – no longer than 1 A4 page
- A completed application form – available for download on the Lock-Up's website
- Support Material
